UNIFORM POLICY

FBCS has a designated uniform which can be purchased at Shreveport Gymnastics, 4727 Line Avenue, 869-1206. There are also some items available in the used uniform room of Dodd Hall. Call the school office for information on purchasing used uniforms. Uniform information is also available on Renweb. Please label all of your children's uniforms, sweatshirts, lunchboxes, etc.

APPEARANCE GUIDELINES

Official uniforms will be worn on all regular school days.

Students should leave their personal vehicle each morning appropriately dressed. If not, they will be asked to return to their vehicle until their clothing is correctly worn.

The uniform must be clean, properly fitting and with no holes. Uniform shirts must be tucked in with belts and waistlines showing. T-shirts worn under uniform shirts must not show any designs or patterns.

Hair may not be of unnatural color or style. Hair should not hang over eyebrows and length must be no longer than the middle of the ear and above collars for boys. Girls are allowed ribbons and bows of school colors. No hair wraps or bandanas.

CONSEQUENCES FOR UNIFORM/DRESS VIOLATIONS

Elementary uniform violations will result in loss of recess time.

In middle school, an infraction will be issued for each uniform/dress violation.

SHIRT

White Peter Pan collar blouse piped in red on collar and sleeves

- Short sleeve
- No school logo
- May be monogrammed on the left collar in red or navy thread

JUMPER

FBCS plaid

- No school logo or monogram

TIGHTS/LEGGINGS

Solid navy tights or leggings

SOCKS

Plain white

- No emblems or logos
- Must be visible

SHOES

- Shoes should not have writing, sparkles, glitter, or lights.
- No sandals, boots, crocks, or flip flops.
- Athletic Shoes (Tennis shoes) MUST be worn during PE classes.
- Shoes that create or cause a distraction during class are not acceptable.

CARDIGANS/JACKETS/COATS AND SWEATSHIRTS

- All cardigans, jackets, and coats must be of the school approved, solid navy choices from Shreveport Gymnastics. They must have the girl school logo on the left chest and may be monogrammed on the right chest in white or red, no larger than 2 ½ inches.

HAIR

RIBBONS/BOWS:

Red, white or navy

May be monogrammed

SHIRT

Red capped sleeve polo; must be Classroom brand

- Short sleeve
- Must have FBCS girl school logo on left chest
- May be embroidered in navy or white thread with three initials on left sleeve just above arm banding (no monogramming on the right chest).
- Must be tucked in at waist

SKIRT/SKORTS

FBCS Plaid

- Length must be no more than 4 inches above middle of the knee.

TIGHTS/LEGGINGS

Solid navy tights or leggings

SOCKS

Plain white

- No emblems or logos
- Must be visible

SHOES

- Shoes should not have writing, sparkles, glitter, or lights.
- No sandals, boots, crocks, or flip flops.
- Athletic Shoes (Tennis shoes) **MUST** be worn during PE classes.
- Shoes that create or cause a distraction during class are not acceptable.

CARDIGANS/JACKETS/COATS AND SWEATSHIRTS

Boys Grades K5 – 5th

SHIRT

Red polo - cotton or dri-fit from Shreveport Gymnastics; Textured Active style form Lands’ End

- Short sleeve
- Must have FBCS boy school logo on left chest
- May be embroidered in navy or white thread with three initials on left sleeve just above arm banding (no monogramming on the right chest)
- Must be tucked in at the waist with visible belt

White plain undershirt

- Must be plain white with no design
- Must be tucked in at the waist
- Must not extend beyond uniform shirt sleeve

PANTS OR SHORTS

Navy

- Tailored, straight leg
- No cargo style pants or shorts
- No logo or label on pants or shorts (no matter how small)

BELT: SOLID BROWN, BLACK, NAVY OR AMERICAN FLAG BELT

SOCKS

Plain white or black socks

- No emblems or logos
- No knee socks
- Must be visible

SHOES

- Shoes should not have writing, sparkles, glitter, or lights.
- No sandals, boots, clogs, or flip flops.
- Athletic Shoes (Tennis shoes) **MUST** be worn during PE classes.
- Shoes that create or cause a distraction during class are not acceptable.

JACKETS/COATS AND SWEATSHIRTS

- Must be approved solid navy outerwear options from Shreveport Gymnastics or Lands’ End and must have the boy school logo on the left chest. May be monogrammed on the right chest in white or red, no larger than 2 ½ inches.
- FBCS sweatshirts sold by the school only
- FBCS sports team outerwear such as basketball sweatshirts may be worn.

HAIR

- Hair may not be an un-natural color or style
- Hair should not hang over eyebrows and length must be no longer than the middle of the ear and above the shirt collar.

SHIRT

Navy capped sleeve polo; must be Classroom brand

- Short Sleeve
- Must have FBCS girl school logo on left chest
- May be embroidered in red or white thread with three initials on left sleeve just above arm banding (no monogramming on the right chest).
- Must be tucked in at waist

SKIRT

FBCS plaid

- Length must be no more than 4 inches above the middle of the knee when kneeling.

TIGHTS/LEGGINGS

Solid navy tights or leggings

SOCKS

Plain white

- No emblems or logos
- No Knee socks
- Must be visible

SHOES

- Shoes should not have writing, sparkles, glitter, or lights.
- No sandals, boots, crocks, or flip flops.
- Athletic Shoes (Tennis shoes) **MUST** be worn during PE classes.
- Shoes that create or cause a distraction during class are not acceptable.

CARDIGANS/JACKETS/COATS AND SWEATSHIRTS

- All cardigans, jackets, and coats must be of the school approved, solid navy choices from Shreveport Gymnastics. They must have the girl school logo on the left chest and may be monogrammed on the right chest in white or red, no larger than 2 ½ inches.
- FBCS sweatshirts sold by the school only

SHIRT

Navy polo - cotton or dri-fit from Shreveport Gymnastics; Textured Active style form Lands’ End

- Short sleeve only
- Must have FBCS boy logo on left chest
- May be embroidered in red or white thread with three initials on left sleeve just above arm banding (no monogramming on the right chest).
- Must be tucked in at the waist with visible belt

White plain undershirt

- Must be plain white with no design
- Must be tucked in at the waist
- Must not extend beyond uniform shirt sleeve

PANTS OR SHORTS

Khaki

- Tailored, straight leg, no logo/label (no matter how small)
- No cargo style pants or shorts
- No logo or label on pants or shorts

BELT: SOLID BROWN, BLACK, NAVY OR AMERICAN FLAG BELT

SOCKS

Plain white or black socks

- No emblems or logos
- No knee socks
- Must be visible

SHOES

- Shoes should not have writing, sparkles, glitter, or lights.
- No sandals, boots, crocks, or flip flops.
- Athletic Shoes (Tennis shoes) **MUST** be worn during PE classes.
- Shoes that create or cause a distraction during class are not acceptable.

PULLOVERS/JACKETS/COATS AND SWEATSHIRTS

- Cardigans, jackets, and coats must be approved solid navy outerwear from Shreveport Gymnastics or Lands’ End and must have the boy school logo on the left chest. May be monogrammed on the right chest in white or red, no larger than 2 ½ inches.
- FBCS sweatshirts sold by the school only
- FBCS sports team outerwear such as letterman jackets and basketball sweatshirts may be worn.

HAIR

- Hair may not be an un-natural color or style

Hair should not hang over eyebrows and length must be no longer than the middle of the ear and above the shirt collar

P.E. UNIFORM

NON-UNIFORM DAY DRESS CODE POLICY

- If designated, the first Friday of each month is non-uniform day. Clothes must be neat and clean with NO HOLES OR TEARS.
- No bare midriffs, see-through garments, undergarment shirts, strapless, spaghetti straps, halter tops, bare back, one shoulder, cut out shoulders, or off-the-shoulder and low cut blouses. No jogging suits or short sets, sweats, tank tops, low-rise pants, cheer shorts or any pants or tops with holes in them. Tops should be long enough so that no bare stomach is showing at any time.
- Students may wear jeans, walking shorts, cargo pants/shorts, Capri pants or uniform shorts or slacks with other shirts or tops. All pants must be hemmed - no cutoffs or wide legs. Pants should be of appropriate length.
- No flip flops, sandals, open back shoes. Uniform shoes, Uggs and boots are acceptable. Athletic shoes are required for PE classes.
- No caps or hats except on special dress days. No scarves covering the head.
- Obscene or profane language, tobacco and alcohol advertisements, or provocative pictures on clothing is prohibited.
- Students may wear uniform, if preferred.
- Parents will be called for violations of this dress code and infractions will be given.
- Leggings and jeggings may be worn if the blouse/shirt extends to the mid-thigh.

SPECIAL DRESS DAYS

- Boys will wear dress or khaki pants with a collared shirt. Sports jackets are acceptable.
- Skirts and dresses for girls are to be no shorter than 4 inches above the middle of the knee (measured while kneeling).
- Parents will be called for violations of this dress code and infractions will be given.
- Non-uniform dress code applies here as well.

FIELD TRIP DAYS

- FBCS t-shirts with jeans or uniforms bottoms are allowed on field trips.
- Non-uniform day guidelines apply for overnight trips only.
